The bursary will be a renewable bursary of up to a maximum \$4,000 per year (based on the specific program requirements), for a maximum of 3 years providing the recipient continues to maintain full-time status and meet eligibility requirements. Must meet **all** criteria below:

- Demonstrate financial need;
- Enrolled in a full-time program at the College;
- Residents of Newfoundland and Labrador and have graduated from a high school in the province;
- In the final year of high school or have graduated within the last 14 months, with confirmation of acceptance at the College for the Fall semester;
- Maintain clear academic standing
- Commit to work with at least one identified mentor Applicant must provide name and contact information of mentor to be eligible.
