• The permit must be affixed to a clear surface (ex: laminated/plastic sleeve) and displayed in the windshield and it must be identifiable from the outside by campus security. If the sticker is not properly displayed and visible a ticket will be issued. Warnings will not be given.

• Parking in the cul-de-sac by the Daycare Centre is prohibited. The City of St. John's will ticket you. Also, the Holiday Inn has contacted campus administration and they will be ticketing and towing vehicles if parked in their lot.

• If you have multiple vehicles you must move the permit to the vehicle you are taking to school that day.

• Parking fines are \$50 for vehicles parked in fire lane and \$100 for parking in a disability parking space. These amounts have been authorized by the Department of Transportation and Works and will be enforced under the authority of the Works Services and Transportation Act.

• Any lost or stolen permits must be reported immediately. A running log of all canceled permits will be maintained. If security finds a canceled permit in a parked vehicle, the vehicle owner will be ticketed. All traffic tickets will be documented and further action will be taken if necessary.

• Students with permits **must** park in the Student Parking Lots Only. If you park in other areas you will receive a parking violation ticket. If you block another vehicle or impede traffic, your vehicle will be towed at your expense.

• If you have classes later in the morning or afternoon we encourage you to use Metrobus or get dropped off at the campus. Carpooling is always a good option, so connect with your classmates.

• Parking in fire lanes, crosswalks or next to door entrances is not permitted. This is for fire and safety reasons, and if parked illegally, your vehicle may be towed at your expense. The road way to Gooseberry Lane is very narrow and parking there is prohibited as it restricts access by emergency vehicles.

• After 3:30 pm only illegal and unsafe parking areas will be ticketed (not the regular parking lot spaces). If you are using the building after 3:30 p.m. you will not require a parking permit.

• Designated contractor parking spaces are not to be occupied by students.



### Student Parking

Parking at both St. John's campuses is by permit only. The number of students requesting parking each semester far exceeds the availability. A random draw will be held at the beginning of the fall semester for the limited number of spaces. The cost of the permit will be determined and communicated prior to the start of the Fall 2016 semester. Please keep this in mind when arranging accommodations and travel for the upcoming school year. Students may wish to consider alternative methods of transportation to alleviate their parking concerns.

Lost or stolen permits must be immediately reported to Room 111 for Ridge Road students and Room G107 for Prince Phillip Drive students. There will be a replacement fee for each lost permit.
