1. PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy applies to all registered students at the College. It is intended to establish the students' general rights and responsibilities and to act as a guide for the students as well as all College personnel.

2. POLICY

It is the policy of the College that all students are expected to conduct themselves in the best interest of the College and themselves. All students are expected to apply themselves to their studies and act with propriety and conform to College policies, rules and regulations. If students do not accept and live up to these responsibilities as outlined, the College reserves the right to take such action as, in its opinion, the case warrants (*See College policy LS-202.*)

3. PROCEDURE

The Vice-President of Academic and Learner Services shall ensure that procedures are developed and implemented in accordance with this policy.
