



Dear Potential Graduate:

The graduation ceremony for Prince Philip Drive, Ridge Road and Seal Cove Campuses will be held on **Thursday, June 21, 2012**. Please read the important information below regarding the graduation exercises. You can also find this information on our campus links, off the main page of the college website.

A name and home town verification list will be sent to all classrooms. If you are on a work term or otherwise not attending your campus at this time, and wish to verify that we have your correct full name and home town, you may contact Jennifer Burge, Learner Services, at jennifer.burge@cna.nl.ca.

To determine if you are a graduate, you must check the Graduate List that will be posted in the main lobby of the Prince Philip Drive, Ridge Road and Seal Cove campuses at 2:00 p.m., Monday, June 18, 2012.

There are two graduation sessions - one at 10:00 a.m. and the other at 2:00 p.m. Please refer to the attached information sheets to determine the session that you will attend. Graduates must arrive at the Arts & Culture Centre at least one and a half hours prior to the beginning of their graduation session.

Restricted parking regulations will be lifted at the Arts and Culture Centre for the duration of the graduation sessions. Please feel free to park in any of the designated parking areas, keeping fire lanes clear and accessing disability parking by permit only.

Please note that both the morning and afternoon sessions of the graduation ceremony at the Art and Culture Centre will be web cast. Some of our distance students are accessing their graduation ceremony through this medium.

In the event that you are a graduate, you should be familiar with the graduation information. Please note that students will not receive their certificates/diplomas if they have outstanding fees. All fees must be paid in full to receive any official documentation from the college.
