DISTANCE LEARNING

CREDIT TRANSFER

Formal articulation agreements with national and international universities allow for transfer of credits to degree programs. In partnership with Memorial University of Newfoundland, CNA also offers Comprehensive Arts & Science Transfer: College-University, which allows students to complete the first year of university at select campus sites.

INTERNATIONAL

CNA welcomes international students. CNA is a participant of World University Services Canada (WUSC), and encourages involvement of staff and faculty in international training initiatives. English as a Second Language (ESL) is offered from beginner to advanced levels.

CNA-QATAR

ADULT BASIC EDUCATION (ABE)

ABE is a high school equivalency program for adults who have not completed high school or wish to upgrade their credentials in one or more subject areas.
