OBTAINING AN APPLICATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Residence is located in a six-story building which houses classrooms, administrative offices, and two and a half co-ed residence floors with a capacity to accommodate 168 students. There are also two wheelchair accessible rooms available. Each occupant of a room is provided with a bed, stationary desk, bookshelves, bulletin board and chair. Each room is double and students are expected to share the room with another student of the same sex. Students must supply all bed linens, towels and personal items.

There are lounges on each floor with a TV/VCR. A telephone hookup for a room can be made available upon request. Free Internet access is available by contacting the Information Technology Department on Campus. Laundry facilities are also available.

A kitchenette is located on each floor for light snacks. Electrical appliances are not permitted in rooms to ensure safety.

There are two Residence Assistants on each floor to assist students who may have concerns and ensure that rules and regulations are followed. Security Staff are available 24 hours a day to provide safety for residents.

The residence building is located in Stephenville. Students should keep this in mind when taking programs located at the Stephenville Crossing site. The distance from Stephenville to Stephenville Crossing is approximately 12 km.

BENEFITS

There are many benefits to living in residence, such as:

- Convenience of cafeteria dining.
- Convenience of being located near downtown Stephenville.
- Opportunity to make new friends.
- Quick access to social and recreational facilities, as well as library and computer facilities.

- Convenience of getting to class without going outside and within walking distance of L.A. Bown for Business & Technology programs (½ km) and Don Wright Building for Electrical (¼ km).

MEAL PLANS

The Room and Board Plan includes a shared room and either ten, fourteen or nineteen meals per week. All meal tickets expire on Sundays. These rates are among the lowest of Canadian Colleges and Universities in Atlantic Canada.
