Female: all people who identify as female, whether they are cisgender or transgender female. Disability: any impairment, including a physical, mental, intellectual, cognitive, learning, communication or sensory impairment or a functional limitation that restricts your ability to perform the daily activities. Permanent Resident of Newfoundland and Labrador: a person who has resided in the province for more than 12 months prior to starting college and who is not an international student or visitor to the province.
