Criteria: Awarded to full-time student currently enrolled in any year of any certificate or diploma level program. Applicants must submit an essay (350-500 words) or short video (three minutes or less) explaining how they represent the description above. Specifically, candidates must describe: how they demonstrate or have demonstrated passion for their field of study; how they recognize and exemplify the values of teamwork; and, how they contribute (have contributed) to making their community a better place (through volunteering, community giving, etc.). Students must be permanent residents of Newfoundland and Labrador.

An application form and a College Reference Form are required. First year students must also submit a College Transcript or a Student Progress Report. Students need to submit a 350-500 typed word essay with the application or students can submit a video (3 minutes or less) to the campus awards representative (Student Development Officer or Guidance Counsellor)

Deadline for applications is mid-January. Please see application form for exact date. Application forms are available on the College website.
