The Hebron Project Diversity Scholarship Fund will assist students from among these four groups, with a preference for those who are enrolled in Engineering Technology and Industrial Trades programs.

Students in Industrial Trades programs must also submit a College Transcript OR a Student Progress Report. Deadline for applications is mid-January. Please see application form for exact date.
