John H. Barry Business Memorial Scholarship

The John H. Barry Business Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a student who graduated high school from Dunne Academy, Stella Maris Academy, Baltimore, Mobile Central High or St. Kevin's High, one of the five high schools in CBDC Celtic Region. This award is based on academic excellence and awarded to a second-year student enrolled full time in any program: preference will be given to students in the following programs: Business Management, Business Administration or Office Administration at any campus location. The late John H. Barry was a volunteer with Celtic Business Development Corporation from June 1998 to January 2008, serving as Chairperson for the last four years. John's support of local business in the Southern Shore / St. Mary's Bay area was unwavering. In addition, he volunteered countless hours of his time on various boards in his pursuit of growing the social / economic climate of the region.
