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Dr. Ian McMaster Scholarship Criteria and Application

The “Dr. Ian McMaster” Scholarship in the amount of \$1000 will be awarded to a student who is a resident of Newfoundland and Labrador and who meets the following criteria, in the order of precedence shown:

1. Is enrolled in an Applied Science/Engineering Technology program that is accredited by Technology Accreditation Canada (TAC), or accepted by AETTNL as leading to membership in the Association;
2. Must either be a student member of AETTNL or have applied for a student membership with all applicable fees paid.

After meeting these criteria, selection will be based (in order of precedence shown) on:

- High academic achievement, specifically the highest total of all marks on the final transcript of the year's work;
- Involvement in extracurricular activities; and,
- Community or volunteer service.

The Application is available on the AETTNL website www.aettnl.com. The deadline for receipt of the application is the close of business of the AETTNL office on **Monday October 13, 2025**. The successful applicant will be notified by email and presented with the Award at the AETTNL Annual General Meeting (AGM) Awards Ceremony. Details of the AGM are available on the AETTNL website.
