

For every \$1...



Students gain \$4.20 in lifetime earnings







The average diploma graduate from CNA will see an increase in earnings of \$19,900 each year compared to someone with a high school diploma working

in Newfoundland & Labrador.



Taxpayers gain \$4.20 in added tax revenue and public sector savings









Society gains \$11.20 in added provincial revenue and social savings
