

## Requirements to Register for CAS Transfer Mathematics Courses

The following chart outlines the requirements to register for CAS Transfer mathematics courses at College of the North Atlantic. This is for students who have completed Mathematics 3200 (advanced mathematics) or Mathematics 3201 (academic mathematics) in high school. These requirements are effective commencing **Fall, 2022**.

| CAS Transfer Courses                | Requirements to Register   |
|-------------------------------------|--|
| MA1120/1121<br>(Finite Mathematics) | At least 50% in Mathematics 3201<br>OR<br>at least 50% in Mathematics 3200<br>OR<br>at least 50% in MA1041 <sup>2</sup>  |
| MA1104<br>(Pre-Calculus)            | At least 75% in Mathematics 3201<br>OR<br>at least 50% in Mathematics 3201 and 55% on the MPT<br>OR<br>at least 50% in Mathematics 3200<br>OR<br>at least 50% in MA1041 <sup>2</sup> |
| MA1130<br>(Calculus I)              | At least 75% in Mathematics 3200<br>OR<br>at least 50% in Mathematics 3200 and at least 75% on the MPT<br>OR<br>at least 50% in MA1104   |
| MA1131<br>(Calculus II)             | At least 50% in MA1130<br>OR<br>An acceptable score on the CPT <sup>3</sup>  |

- Students who score below 40% on the MPT must successfully complete both MA1040<sup>2</sup> and MA1041<sup>2</sup> before being permitted to register for MA1104.
- Students who obtain a mark between 40% and 54% on the MPT must satisfactorily complete MA1041<sup>2</sup> before registering for MA1104.
- A combination of the high school mark and the MPT helps to ensure placement of the student in the appropriate mathematics course.

<sup>1</sup> The MPT (Mathematics Placement Test) is a diagnostic test of basic skills in mathematics consisting of 100 multiple choice questions. It can only be written once and the use of a calculator is not permitted.

<sup>2</sup> MA1040 and MA1041 are courses in the College's CAS Transition program designed to strengthen students' mathematical knowledge and skills. Students obtain credit in the College system but the courses are not transferable to MUN.

<sup>3</sup> The CPT (Calculus Placement Test) can be written by students who successfully complete Mathematics 3208. Students can obtain credit for MA1130 if they successfully pass the CPT.
