Graduation Ceremony -- St. John's Region -

Prince Philip Drive, Ridge Road, & Seal Cove Campuses

#### When is the graduation ceremony?

- o The graduation ceremony will take place on Thursday June 12th, and Friday, June 13th, 2025.
  - o June 12th, 2025
    - Session One School of Heath Sciences & All Early Childhood Education programs including online will be at 10:00 AM
    - Session Two School of Academics, Applied Arts and Tourism except Early Childhood Education will be at 2:00 PM
  - o June 13th, 2025
    - Session One School of Business and Information Technology will be at 10:00 AM
    - Session Two School of Engineering Technology & School of Natural Resources & Industrial Trades will be at 2:00 PM

#### What is the location?

- The graduation ceremony will take place at the Arts and Culture Centre.

# How do I know if I am graduating?

• You will be advised via College email, <u>if you have registered</u> for the Graduation Ceremony, and you are **NOT potentially eligible to graduate**.

# What is the process for picking up the tickets?

- Tickets MUST be picked up between May 22nd June 9<sup>th</sup> (8:30 am 4:00 pm) during regular business hours, except for May 28<sup>th</sup>. On May 28<sup>th</sup> 2025, tickets can be picked up from 8:30am 6:00pm.
- There will be NO ticket pick up at the Arts and Culture Centre on the day of the ceremony.
  - o There will be **NO ADMITTANCE TO THE CEREMONY**, if you **do not** present a Guest Ticket.
- Photo ID must be presented to pick up tickets. If for some reason you are not able to pick up your tickets yourself, you will need written consent through your <u>college email</u> stating that you give consent for someone else to pick up your tickets in your absence.
